We also ask that people wanting to utilize the hotspots be respectful of the businesses that are operating. We would recommend parking towards the outer areas of the parking lots so their employees and customers can still access their businesses.

Our hotspots will be broadcasting the **Wi-Fi name school.ligtel.com**, you will need a password to access the hotspot, this will be provided by the school system the child is enrolled at. LigTel has also programmed hotspots to be available during the hours of 8:00 am and 9:00 pm, and there is content filtering on all the access points, so only school appropriate materials will be allowed on the system.

We plan to operate the hotspots until the schools reopen or after the end of the school year. LigTel does reserve the right to shutdown access points due to vandalism of property or other issues arising from the placement of the hotspot in a location.
